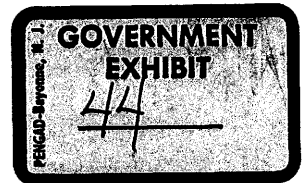

This will be our third report, second report being sent on 26th November.

Specific remarks to specific brokers will be found as a postscript.

ATTENDING VETERINARIAN'S REPORT: We are enclosing Dr. Baker's report and he confirms first attendance on 13th November, finding that on that same date ALYDAR suffered with a mid-shaft transverse and compound type fracture in the right rear cannon bone. He reports the injury occurred when the stallion kicked the stall door, with first discovery by night watchman, Alton Stone, on a routine check. He also placed first signs at being approximately 10p.m. on 13th November 1990.

Dr. Baker also confirms the fractured leg was placed in a splint on 13th November, followed by surgery on 14th November to reduce the fracture along with placement of plate and cast, with the second fracture occurring on 15th November involving the right femur bone. He also confirmed euthanasia at 8:20a.m. on 15th November 1990, describing it as being based upon humane reasons.

CURRENT STATUS: We are also enclosing copy of the original Jockey Club Certificate of Registration, confirming that ALYDAR was a homebred and there is no change of ownership, as shown on the reverse side. The registration papers also match the tattoo provided by the veterinarians (E21991).

FUTURE ACTIVITY: We will continue to forward appropriate Proof of Loss Forms as they arrive in our office and we will also be providing your office with our pro rated bill for service.
